Participation in this clinic is on a first come first served basis so get your entry form and fees in as soon as possible to ensure that you are included.

NSEF or NBEF membership is required.

It is a clinic for riders or drivers. If riding, you must be able to trot with confidence. Drivers are expected to know how to harness and hitch a horse with some experience driving. In all cases, the horse must be considered to be safe in a clinic environment held in an indoor arena. Sessions will be tailored to the individual's level of experience from beginner to advanced.

Horses can arrive any time after 12 noon on Friday. Bedding is included with the stabling fee and arrangements can be made to have your horse fed (with your feed) and watered in the mornings at no additional charge.

No dogs are permitted in the arena or barn area.

A canteen will be available during the clinic.

The \$125 clinic registration fee covers the Clinic Participant and the specified Clinic Horse for one discipline with one 45 minute session on Saturday and another on Sunday. There will be only 2 horses in each session. When possible, participants in the same discipline will be paired. The clinic will start promptly at 8am each morning and end around 5 pm each day.

Formal show attire is not required; however, helmets are encouraged for all and are required for anyone under 18 years of age.

Seating will be available in the arena for auditors.

All are welcome to attend an informal Saturday Evening Pizza / Q&A Session with Valarie Siemer, from 6 pm until 8 pm. The cost is \$10. per person. Advance notice for planning purposes would be appreciated; however, the deadline is noon on Saturday, April 24th.
